# The Development Corporation of Abilene, The City of Abilene, and Taylor County Win National 2022 Impact Award from Business Facilities Magazine in Renewable Energy Category

*Abilene, Texas* - The Development Corporation of Abilene (DCOA) announced today that through its partnership with the City of Abilene and Taylor County, the recent Lancium project has been honored by Business Facilities Magazine with the 2022 Deal of the Year Impact Award in the Renewable Energy Category. Lancium projects a total capital investment of \$2.4 billion and creation of 57 full-time jobs over 20 years to build their 1-Gigawatt Clean Campus on over 1,000 acres in Taylor County and Abilene. Lancium's investment in this new campus will solidify Abilene and Taylor County as a major provider of renewable energy and become home to a variety of industries that are powered by low-cost renewable energy. The campus will also enhance the community's workforce, tapping into a skilled labor force in the technical services industry.

The 2022 Business Facilities Impact Awards recognized 18 outstanding economic development projects in various categories, including renewable energy, workforce development, infrastructure, and more. A panel of nationally recognized site consultants participated in selecting this year's winners.
